Harry Andrew Dennard, Sr. beloved husband, father, grandfather and friend passed away at the age of 77 on Monday, December 12, 2016.

Born in 1939 to Floyd H. and Gladys Ruth Dennard in Atlanta, GA where he was raised, leaving to serve in the Marine Corps from 1957 – 1960 and then attended Georgia Tech. Harry came to Tallahassee in the early 1970s with his wife Sandra where he worked as a field representative, area manager, and state manager for Woodman of the World Life Insurance Society, retiring in 1999.

Harry, a disciple of Christ, was a member of the Church of Christ, serving as a deacon and elder at the Timberlane Church of Christ and later as an active member of Meridian Woods Church of Christ and the Seven Hills Church.

Harry was passionate about serving children in need and served many years on the Board of Directors of Raintree Village Children's Home in Valdosta, GA. Another passion, history, led Harry to serve as president of the nonprofit Friends of the Governor Stone leading the restoration project of that 100 year old vessel. Harry served on many other charitable and nonprofit organizations throughout his life.

Harry is survived by his wife of 56 years Sandra Dennard, daughter Marshelle Rampy (Mark Rampy), daughter Misty Bennett (Lance Bennett), son Andrew Dennard, grandchildren Matthew Rampy (Pamela Rampy), Joseph Rampy and Davidson Bennett, as well as his sisters: Sarah Hines, Jet Negas (Ted Negas), Sandra Stark (Jim Stark), Drenda Dennard and many nieces and

nephews. Harry was preceded in death by his brothers Floyd H Dennard and Sammy P Dennard.
