Heide Wacker Clifton of Crawfordville passed away peacefully on June 21, 2016 at her home with her friends and her dogs by her side. Heide was born on September 4, 1939 in Bremerhaven, Germany to Hugo Alfred Wacker, a marine officer, and Margarete Christiansen Wacker. Heide moved to America in 1962 and developed a career in accounting with TMH and the State of Florida Legislative offices.

Heide was predeceased in death by her husband of 38 years, Charles "Chick" Clifton, who retired from the Auditor General's office. After Heide and Chick retired they devoted their lives to rescuing abandoned and neglected animals. Heide fought for protection of the animals in Wakulla County which led to the establishment of CHAT and the Wakulla County Adoption Center.

Heide will always be remembered for the heritage roses she propagated for the annual rose sale she held for 20 years to raise money for the adoption center.

Heide returned to her love of horses after the adoption center was closed by the county and she enjoyed three years at Mahan Farms with her horse, Trouble.
