Helen Green Crosby, beloved mother, grandmother, and friend, entered into the presence of her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on August 30, 2025, at the age of 85. She was born on February 18, 1940, in Pavo, GA, and lived a life marked by faith, generosity, and love. She graduated high school in 1958 and married the love of her life Richard Russell Crosby, Sr. on October 13, 1961.

She was an outspoken Christian who never wavered in sharing her faith in Jesus. Her confidence in Him brought peace to her family, who know without a doubt that she is now in heaven. She lived out her faith through prayer, service and encouraging those around her.
