December 5, 1929 - July 27, 2024

Born in Shreveport, LA, on December 5, 1929, Helen Bernice Fletcher grew up in the home of a Gadsden County farmer turned oil field worker and his homemaker wife. After graduating from high school, Helen worked as a secretary. It was her little brother Don who introduced her to the tall, dark, handsome airman who would become her husband. Andy Myers was playing baseball with Don and some other kids in the neighborhood and spotted Helen when he gave Don a ride home. Andy invited Helen to grab some ice cream. He also grabbed Helen and held on all the way to the altar! Together, they raised three kids and survived decades of service in the Air Force.

As Andy fought for his country in places like Korea and Vietnam, Helen faithfully fought to hold the family together on the home front. She made sure that Sharon, Art, and Mike were well-clothed, fed, and educated and that they didn't kill each other—no small feat since the boys were fond of firecrackers and even larger explosives.

After the vagabond military life that took them to such far-flung places as Hawaii, Colorado, and Washington, DC, Helen loved her last home in Tallahassee, where she finally put down roots for good. She enjoyed good music, friendly neighbors, and growing plants and flowers of all kinds and colors. She was loved and will be missed by her surviving family: daughter Sharon Latimer Jackson (Daniel) of Temple, TX; sons Art Myers (DeeDee) of

Tallahassee and Mike Myers (Barb) of Havana, FL; grandson Joshua Myers of Havana; granddaughter Tiffany Myers of California; brother Don Fletcher (Carolyn) and nephew Stephen of Gadsden County, FL; niece Jan Read of Bossier City, LA; and other nieces and nephews.
