Helen R. Scott made the transition from earth into eternity on Saturday, February 2, 2013. She was 88 years old.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM, EST, Wednesday, February 6, 2013 at Lakeview Baptist Church in Tallahassee. Burial will follow at Roselawn Cemetery, also in Tallahassee. The Scott family will receive friends Tuesday, February 5th from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM at Bevis Funeral Home in Tallahassee.

Mrs. Scott was a native of Winter Haven, Florida, and moved to Tallahassee from Brinson, Georgia in 1955. She retired from the Leon County School System following 24 years of service as the Lunch Room Manager at Ruediger Elementary School. Mrs. Scott was also a member of Lakeview Baptist Church for the past 56 years.
