Helen Eubanks Whaley, 92, passed away peacefully on October 16, 2021, in Palm Harbor, Florida..

Helen was born in Wakulla County on September 20, 1929, to Ross and Verdie Belle (Gray) Eubanks. She graduated from Sopchoppy High School in 1947 and enjoyed working in Tallahassee before marrying William E. Whaley on June 10, 1950. After living in Virginia during Willie's military service and Gainesville while he earned his degree, they returned to Wakulla to raise their family. When her youngest child started elementary school, Helen went back to school too. After graduating from Florida State University in 1971, Helen began her career as a teacher at Wakulla High School where she taught business education, sponsored many senior classes, and accompanied students on senior trips and to FBLA conventions. After retiring in 1991, Helen and Willie enjoyed traveling, tending their garden and animals, and being grandparents. After his death in 1999, Helen continued to enjoy traveling with her sister, Annette, and good friends from her church and community.

Throughout her life, Helen was a devout Christian and involved member of her church and community. Helen's favorite place was with her loving family and many close friends, a smile on her face, her hair 'did', wearing the perfect outfit, and enjoying a good meal with lots of laughter and hugs for everyone in attendance. She will be missed and fondly remembered by everyone who

loved her.
