



## Mr. Herbert Homer "Jack" Salyer Jr.

January 10, 1934 - June 11, 2012

Herbert Homer "Jack" Salyer Jr. passed away unexpectedly in Tallahassee, Fla., on, June 11, 2012, after a brain hemorrhage. A memorial celebration will be held Saturday, June 16, 2012, at 10:30 a.m. at the Tallahassee Senior Center.

Herb was a member of Woodland Hills Community Church and the local coordinator of Seniors v. Crime at the senior center. In September 2001, he and his wife of 56 years, Mary, moved to Tallahassee from Ashland, Ky., where he worked at AK Steel (previously Armco) beginning in 1952 until retiring in 1994. A lifelong sports enthusiast, he was president of Herb's Art and Collectibles during his retirement.

Born January 10, 1934, in Mud Lick (Johnson County, Ky.) his parents moved to Ashland in 1940. He had various jobs growing up, including delivering milk to people's homes. After graduating from Ashland High School in 1952, he took classes at Ashland Junior College, then worked in the steel mill and later served in the U.S. Army from 1956 to 1959, including 18 months in Germany.

After his military service, he returned to the mill and later graduated from Morehead State University. At Armco, he was promoted to employment supervisor, and eventually to superintendent.

To many, he was a mentor, father-figure and trusted resource for godly counsel. Known for his generosity and willingness to share, he consistently closed prayers with “Make us ever mindful of the needs of others.”

He is survived by his wife Mary (Daniel) and daughter Sheila, both of Tallahassee, as well as nephews and their wives of Ashland: Mark and Teresa Slone, Brent Slone and Tom and Jeannie Stafford. He was a devoted great uncle to Chris Slone of Ashland (and wife Erin and children Rylan and Eden), Alison (Slone) Stumpfl of Baltimore, Maryland (and husband R.J. and daughter Bella) and Zachary Stafford. He was preceded in death by his parents Herbert Homer Salyer Sr. and June (Stambaugh) and his sister Kathleen Slone.
