Hershel LeRoy Trotman, 76, of Miccosukee, FL went to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Sunday morning, May 20, 2018. He was born on January 12, 1942 in Tallahassee, FL, to John Carl and Janie Lou Trotman. He was a life-long resident of Leon County and graduated from Leon High School. LeRoy was a master electrician who blessed many Florida counties with his services including Disney World's It's a Small World and Swiss Family Treehouse exhibits; the Crystal River Nuclear Power Plant; and the Florida State Capitol building, as well as others, before starting T & S Electric with Tommy Stover in 1976. He loved the Lord and has been a leadership member of Miccosukee United Methodist for 52 years. His love for his church ran deep. He believed in loving your neighbor not only by words, but by actions and showing them through Christ-like service. He believed in celebrating life's moments, whether it was a birthday, anniversary, graduation, 4th of July or especially a fish fry, "just because."
