Irma Jean Lett, 89, passed peacefully into her heavenly reward on Saturday, July 26, 2025, at home in Gadsden County, surrounded by her children.

In her later years, she attended the Pentecostals of the Capital City, where she received the Holy Ghost and was baptized in Jesus' name. A Bible or devotional was never far from her chair, reflecting her deep and abiding trust in the Lord.

Jean is survived by her children Jon (Faithe) and Joni (Brian); grandchildren Ryan (LeAnn), Whitney, Brandon (Megan), Taylor (Brandon), and Kyle; and great-grandchildren Jillian, Ava, Ricki Grace, Rylee Ann, and Stella. She is also survived by her siblings Benny (Shirley), Roy (Sally), and Charlotte (Richard), along with many beloved nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents, her son Tommy, and her devoted husband, Billy.
