James Andrew Chorey of Tallahassee, Florida passed away on September 19, 2023, after a hard fought battle with cancer.

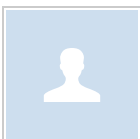

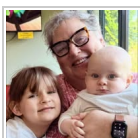
