James Terrell Conner, 76, passed away December 2, 2013. He was born July 31, 1937 to Terrell and Lenora Conner. James grew up in Cordele where he was active in sports at Cordele High School. He was a radio announcer at the local radio station. He attended technical school and was an Army veteran.
