James Duggan Fulghum, Jr., 85, died Saturday, June 2, 2012 at home. He was born in Atlanta, Georgia on February 1, 1927.

Jim graduated from Leon High School in 1945 and served in the U.S. Navy Aviation Cadet Program from 1945 thru 1947.
