James A. Powell, 81, of Lake Tallavana, FL, passed away on December 8, 2010 in Tallahassee, Florida. He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Patricia Powell.

A native of Findlay, Ohio, James spent most of his life in Tallahassee until retiring to Havana in 1990. He was honorably discharged from the U.S. Navy in 1946 and the U.S. Army in 1959 where he served in the Korean Conflict as a CIC Agent. He graduated from the University of Michigan with a degree in Forestry and Wildlife. James began his career with the Florida Game and Freshwater Fish Commission as a Field Biologist in 1952. He served as Chief of Game Management for the Game Commission during his 38 year career. He was an avid naturalist and enjoyed hunting, fishing and raising orchids in his spare time. He was a dedicated family man and prided himself on being a good provider.

Other survivors include three children, Jeffrey Powell(Jill) of Umatilla, FL; Mark Powell(Janice) of Tallahassee; and Lisa Crossman(Christopher) of Atlanta; seven grandchildren; and one great grandchild.
