



## James Lackey Spicer

October 22, 1946 - September 9, 2025

James Lackey Spicer, 78, son of Lackey and Mabel Spicer, passed away suddenly on Tuesday, September 9, 2025, while on a visit to South Dakota.

He was born in Rutherford County, NC and attended R.S. Central High School in Rutherfordton, NC. After graduation he was drafted into the army and served honorably from 1968 to 1970. He married Susan LeValley Spicer on April 23, 1971. James worked in the automobile industry all his life and retired from Ferman Nissan in December of 2013.
