May 29, 1953 - May 10, 2024

Janice "Jan" Ann Smith Bubsey passed away peacefully but tragically on May 10, 2024, while in the care of Shands Hospital in Gainesville, Florida.

Jan was born on May 29, 1953, in Charleston, West Virginia, to Jasper F. Smith and Patrica Ann Crews Smith. She was raised in Milton, Florida, with her three sisters Sharon Dupree, Michelle Sulcer, and Becky Schepper.

She married William Edward Bubsey in Kailua, Oahu, Hawaii, on March 16, 1973, becoming the wife of a Marine Corps officer. For the next 22 years until his retirement, she raised the family in Atlanta; Newport, Rhode Island; Camp Lejeune, North Carolina; Okinawa, Japan; Charlottesville; Beaufort, South Carolina; and New Orleans. The family moved to Tallahassee in 1992.

Jan had many skills and hobbies, to include antique collecting, cooking savory delights, sewing, gardening, bird watching, and boating. Earlier she was quite skilled at tennis and golf. She loved the North Georgia Mountains.

Jan also found time to work in the golf industry, first in Beaufort, South Carolina, then New Orleans and Tallahassee.

Jan was an event coordinator for the Tallahassee Parks and Recreation Department working principally on The Winter Festival and additionally later the Fourth of July Celebration at Tom Brown Park.

Jan was a loving wife, mother, and grandmother.

Jan was preceded in death by her parents and her sisters' husbands. She is survived by her husband, her daughter Erica Lea, son Warren Blake and his wife Lesley, and granddaughters Katherine Blake, Renley Evella, and Reagan Allureanna, and her sisters.
