Jean Liggett passed away February 24th at age 90 in Tallahassee, Florida. She was born February 26, 1926 in the Chicago suburb of Oak Park, Illinois to Anjelica (Anne) Kolar and Merle Vernon.

After a few years in New Jersey, during the Depression the family moved to a farmstead near Bangor, Michigan. She married Clyde Thomas, a Michigan State Trooper, in 1948. They lived in South Haven, Bangor, Gaylord and in 1956 moved to Niles, Michigan. Jean was widowed in 1963 and began working in the office at Niles High School, where she retired after 22 years. In 1975 Jean married Wayne Liggett of South Bend and they spent 25 years together. After Wayne's death, Jean moved to Tallahassee, Florida to be with family where she attended Blessed Sacrament Church. Jean spent the last several years in the Westminster Oaks continuing care community.
