



Rev. Jeffery Lewis McFalls

March 31, 1962 - March 8, 2014

Jeffery Lewis McFalls, age 51, Crawfordville, FL, went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, March 8, 2014.

Jeff was born March 31, 1962 in Charlotte, NC. He is survived by his loving wife of 24 ½ years Elizabeth Brown McFalls (Libby), his sons Zachary Adam McFalls (Zac), Doran Blake McFalls, his daughter Sydney Abigail McFalls (Abbi), his Father, Bobby L. McFalls, Charlotte, NC, his sister, Sharron McFalls, Charlotte, NC and his brother, Michael McFalls (and wife Jeannie) Charlotte, NC and their two daughters, Emilee and Maddie McFalls. He is preceded in death by his mother, Shirley Mae Broome McFalls.

Jeff was saved in November, 1984, and called into the ministry shortly thereafter. He is a graduate of Lee College (University) where he went to school in preparation for his ministerial calling. He met his wife Libby there and they married in August, 1989. He graduated Magna Cum Laude in the spring of 1991. His first pastoral assignment was as youth pastor at Bloomington Church of God in Bloomington MN from 1991 – 1992. He then served as youth pastor at Calvary Assembly of God, Fayetteville, NC from 1992 – 1994 and Evangel Temple Assembly of God in Columbus, GA from 1994 – 1999. God then called him to a small town in the northern panhandle of Florida – Crawfordville, to a small church called Medart Assembly of God where he served as the lead pastor from August, 1999 until his death. He has also served as a sectional Presbyter with the Assemblies of God for 5 years. He was an ordained Assemblies of God minister and servant of the king for

nearly 30 years.

His celebration service will be Thursday, March 13, 2014 at 11:00 a.m., at the Medart Assembly of God, Crawfordville, FL with internment at Ivan Assembly of God following. Visitation with the family will be Wednesday night, March 12, 2014, from 6-8 at Medart Assembly of God.
