Jeffrey Henry Courtemanche, Tallahassee, died October 7, 2015 at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital after a brief illness.

Born February 8, 1945 in Faribault, MN to Maj. (Ret., U.S. Army Corps of Engineers) Henry and Margaret Courtemanche (both deceased), he was a longtime resident of Florida. Jeff, a former Naval Reservist, moved to Tallahassee in 1976 and never left.
