John W. Carmody, age 83 entered into rest on January 3, 2021. He was born in Rochester, NY and was a long-time resident of Tallahassee. John retired from the Florida Highway Patrol as Deputy Director Special Operations in 1993, he spent a major portion of his career in the South Florida area, including serving as commander of Troop E., Miami.

John was dedicated to serving the state of Florida. During his 37 years with the Florida Highway Patrol he worked many special details. During his career his greatest honor was shaking Pope John Paul's hand in 1987. He took great pride in his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchild, and was always there to lend a guiding hand.

John was a member of Good Shepherd Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus.
