John Patrick Crona, 54, passed away Saturday, April 7, 2012 at his home in Tampa, Florida of natural causes.

He was born July 20, 1957 in Tallahassee, Florida, the son of James T. Crona and Hazel B. Crona. He served as a helicopter mechanic with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) as a member of the Polar Bear Project in the Canadian Arctic, and participated in its research and tracking of whales, dolphins and porpoises in the South Atlantic Ocean and Caribbean. He was also employed with US Customs in Miami, Florida.

His hobbies included restoration of old homes, fishing and playing golf. He is survived by his son, Staff Sergeant John Brian Crona, currently serving in the US Air Force stationed at McConnell Air Force Base in Kansas, his mother Hazel B. Crona, his brothers, Jim (Susan) Crona, Bill (Jane) Crona and his sister, Anita C. (Jim) Sunday, all of Tallahassee. He will also be fondly missed by many nieces, nephews, cousins and friends. He was preceded in death by his father, James T. Crona III.
