



## Jon Mark Gluesenkamp

November 3, 1956 - February 26, 2024

Jon Mark Gluesenkamp (Mark), 67, of Tallahassee, Florida, passed away on February 26, 2024, following a series of medical complications. Born in Charleston, West Virginia, Mark relocated to Tallahassee with his family at an early age.

Mark enjoyed a long career as a creative and skilled finish carpenter. Passionate about nature and wildlife, he was happiest with a fishing pole in hand and shared his love of animals and beautiful sunsets with everyone. He made many wonderful memories at FSU football games, on camping trips, and at the beach. He delighted in his children's accomplishments, eagerly sharing their successes with anyone willing to listen. A beloved member of Alcoholics Anonymous, Mark took great pride in his near-decade of sobriety and loved his fellow AAers like family. He was rarely seen without his sweet rescue dog, Penny, by his side.

Mark is preceded in death by his parents, Gordon and Demarius Gluesenkamp, as well as his brother, Gordon Jerome Gluesenkamp, Jr., and his sister Judith Kay Gluesenkamp. Mark is survived by his wife Ellen Gluesenkamp; two children, daughter Gamble Scott (Andrew) of Jacksonville and son Weber Gluesenkamp (Melissa) of Tallahassee. Mark is also survived by his two beloved granddaughters, Violet and Clara Scott, who affectionately called him "Grumps."
