Joseph M. Fischer, age 96 entered into rest August 2, 2020. He was born in Dayton, Ohio and had lived in Tallahassee since 2006. A graduate of Stivers High School in Dayton. Joseph served in the US Army in the Battery C 254th Field Artillery Battalion during World War II. He received many medals including three Bronze Stars, World War II Victory Medal and a commendation from President Harry S. Truman. Joseph was a Radio Operator in the European Theater of Operations for 26 months. While living in Dayton he was a member of the Patterson Park Church. After moving to Tallahassee, he became a member of Immanuel Baptist Church. He enjoyed helping others, exercise and working with his hands. Joseph built his own home for his family in the early 1950's. Joseph was preceded in death by his wife Eloise L. Broadway Fischer. Survivors include his daughters, Lynne Mulder and her husband Gerry of Tallahassee, Lee Ann Willock of Sarasota; son J. Jeffrey Fischer and his wife Diane of Tampa; numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren and dear friend Elna Sapp.
