Joyce Pannell Wollschlager, 85, of Tallahassee, passed away at her residence on Thursday, November 5, 2015.

Joyce was born near Cochran, GA, December 31, 1929. Her parents, Thomas and Evelyn Pannell, moved with her to Saint Simons Island, GA. Joyce graduated from Georgia State College for Women and taught second grade in Atlanta, GA. She met Phil Wollschlager in Atlanta and they were married July 17, 1954.

Phil and Joyce moved to Tallahassee, FL in 1958 and lived here the rest of their lives. Joyce helped her husband build his dental practice and worked with him through the years. Joyce was active in her children's schools serving as the first PTO president at Gilchrist Elementary School.
