Judith Wardynski “Judy” Bascom, 78, a retired local restaurant owner and caterer, passed away peacefully, surrounded by family, on Monday, May 24, 2021, in Tallahassee, Florida. Judy was preceded in death by her beloved husband, James Robert “Jim” Bascom, who passed in September of 2002.

Judy is survived by her two sons, Michael P. Bascom and Robert J. Bascom, their wives Sarah Bascom and Fawn Bascom, and her two granddaughters Maya Bascom and Kate Bascom, all of Tallahassee.
