July 24, 1923 - June 28, 2016

Julia Mays Wood, 92 of Tallahassee, passed into the Lord's presence on June 28. Julia was from the long standing Tallahassee families- the Mays' and the Woodwards, from whom Woodward Avenue was named and where a portion of Florida State University now stands.

At age 16, Julia became the youngest female pilot in the State of Florida. She graduated from Leon High School in 1941 and went on to graduate from the Florida State College for Women where she was a member of the Chi Omega sorority. After graduation she worked at the airport for the Tallahassee Weather Bureau.

Julia married her high school sweetheart, Charles S. Wood, and the two were married 67 years. In all that she did she displayed God's tender loving kindness. She was a gracious and faithful wife, mother and friend. Julia was a member of Grace Church of Tallahassee and the Babies' Breath Garden Circle.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Charles S. Wood. Survivors include her daughter Fran Ferenchick of Tallahassee, Florida, daughter Jan McClure of Atlanta, Georgia, son Chip Wood of Gulf Breeze, Florida, sister Mary Ellen Bryson of Tallahassee, Florida, step brother, George Walker of Tallahassee, 11 grandchildren and 21 great grandchildren.
