June 20, 1946 - January 27, 2018


Julius Henderson Buford died Saturday, January 27 following a short illness. Julius was born in Tallahassee on June 20, 1946 to Albert Lewis (Jack) Buford, Sr. and Marion Ferrell Buford. He attended local public schools, graduating from Leon High School in 1964. Following graduation from Florida State University he worked for several years with the Florida Department of Transportation. In 1976 he opened Baden-Baden, a truly unique and successful gift and card shop, which he operated until his retirement in December 2017.

Julius was predeceased by his father and by a step-son, James L. Hanks. He is survived by his mother, his wife, Francis Elofson Buford, two daughters, Alycia Lynn Boudreau (Brent) and Darien Gallian (Levi), a step-son Le Hanks (Catherine), his brother Jack Buford, Jr., sister, Mary Frances Buford , and six grandchildren.
