June Marie Barnette Sands took her final journey in the early morning hours of Easter Sunday, April 9, 2023, in Tallahassee, FL. June was born October 28, 1935 in Deland, FL to Ralph and Mary Frank Barnette. The family moved to Quincy, FL soon thereafter, and finally to Tallahassee when June was in the 11th grade.

An accomplished musician, June played trombone at Leon High School and was a Marching Chief at Florida State University. She married Thomas Sands in 1955. They moved to Atlanta, GA, where Tom worked for Southern Bell Telephone. There they had two children, Tom Jr. and Valerie. Sadly, Tom Sr. was killed in an Army airplane accident in 1964, after having rejoined the Army.

Widowed at the age of 28, with two young children, June moved back home to Tallahassee to be closer to family. She re-enrolled at FSU and earned a Master's Degree in Social Work. She spent the majority of her career at Florida State Hospital in Chattahoochee as a psychiatric social worker. Upon her retirement, she indulged her hobbies of spending time at the beach, crafting, crocheting, and enjoying time with her many friends and family.

To know June was to love her. Her tender mercies were given to countless people, from clients to friends and to family. Her radiant smile and Christmas

parties were legend.

June is survived by her children, Tom Sands, Jr. and Valerie Weeks (John), niece Erika Waldeck (Brad Ilowit) and great-nephew Wiley Ilowit, great-niece Nicole Guzzardo (Justin), grandchildren Holly Meyer (Steve), Charles Weeks (Jennifer) and Patty Weeks, great-grandchildren Kaitlyn and Amberlyn Weeks, and Ariel and Haylee Carter, and Bonus Niece, Joyce Murray. She was pre-deceased by her parents, her sisters Mary Barnette Waldeck and Carol Barnette, and her husband Thomas F. Sands, Sr.
