



Kathleen Sherrill "Kay" Hudgens

March 15, 1919 - June 11, 2012

Kathleen Sherrill "Kay" Hudgens, 93, passed away in Tallahassee, Florida, on June 11, 2012. She was born on March 15, 1919, in Goldau, Switzerland. She immigrated to the United States with her parents at two years of age and grew up in the Tacoma, Washington, area. She began playing piano at age 5 and studied music at the College of Puget Sound. She was active in church music programs throughout her life. Kay married Elmore Hudgens during World War II while he was serving in the United States Navy. After the war, they lived in Texas, Pennsylvania, and North Carolina. She worked alongside her husband by starting and operating the Brotherhood of St. Andrew bookstore while he was National Secretary. They were also active in Faith Alive, a lay witnessing ministry. After Elmore's death, she lived in Colorado, North Carolina, and Florida. Kay is survived by a daughter, Sherrill "Sherri" McNeece, and a son, Elmore "Tex" Hudgens, both of Tallahassee. She is also survived by 5 grandchildren: Stefanie (McNeece) Schimborski, John McNeece, Lee Hudgens, Maryellen (Hudgens) Shannon, and Stephen Hudgens, 3 great-grandchildren: Britney Ringo, Kelsey Storlien, and Cy Storlien, and 1 great-great-grandchild, Adelyn Cooley.
