



Kathleen Tsacrios Talantis

February 13, 1923 - April 5, 2025

It is with profound love and heavy hearts that we announce the passing of our mother Kathleen Tsacrios Talantis at the age of 102 years. Born in Live Oak, Florida, she entered eternal rest in Tallahassee, Florida on April 11, 2025. She was a cherished wife, mother, sister, grandmother, great grandmother, aunt, cousin, friend and a pillar of her community, who left this world surrounded by love and never having met a stranger.

Kathleen was better known as 'Aunt Kat' and 'YiaYia' to her family and many friends. She was the daughter of immigrant parents Michael N. and Coula M. Tsacrios of Live Oak, Florida, where she was raised along with three siblings who preceded her in death: Phyllis Tsacrios Andrews, Nicky M. Tsacrios and Janet Tsacrios Gavalas. She graduated from Suwannee High School and worked alongside her kinfolds in their family-owned restaurant where she met her husband James N. Talantis.

James and Kathleen were originally married in Panama City and remained married for 63 years living in Tuscaloosa, Clearwater and Jacksonville before finally settling in Tallahassee where they owned two retail clothing businesses. They were founding members and very devout stewards of Holy Mother of God Greek Orthodox Church where Kathleen remained continually actively involved after her husband passed away in 2005. A couple of years ago, Kathleen was relocated to an Assisted Living facility in Altamonte Springs to

be nearer to her daughter Diane for her care.

Kathleen is survived by their son Nicholas James Talantis and daughter Diane J. Talantis Levine. Grand children Gina Talantis Gjurich, Nicholas James Talantis, Jr., Kristen Talantis Taras, Jamey Binneveld and great grandchildren Aiden Gjurich, Carter and Lucy Taras.
