Kenneth Eugene Boles, 89 years of age, passed on Tuesday, August 9, 2022 at his home.

Kenneth "Ken" was born on January 2nd, 1933 in Milton, Florida to the late BB and Catherine Boles. He was the fourth of six boys, four preceded him in death.

He is survived by his four daughters, Kenda Blanche (Tim) Baxter; Kaylyn Elizabeth (Blair) Minnix; Gwendolyn Elise Rolling; and Katherine Joyce Walmer. He had a son, Kenneth (Christa) Schedl, who also preceded him in death. Ken has several grandchildren and great-grandchildren who he loved dearly.

Ken served in the Army, attaining the rank of sergeant, during the Korean war and was stationed in Germany. He was a proud American and loved serving his country.

He was a general contractor for many years in Ft. Walton Beach, Florida. He also served in the House of Representatives for the Fifth District from 1978 to 1982. In the latter years of his life he worked for the State of Florida in Tallahassee.

He was a life-long Florida State Seminole. As he always said, "I was a 'Nole

before it was cool". If there was a FSU football game on, you better bet Ken was watching.

He was active in the Masons and Shriners for most of his life and obtained a 50-year pin. Ken was also a member of the Krewe of Bowlegs in Ft. Walton Beach for several years in the 1970s and 80s.

Ken loved life and enjoyed it to its fullest. At the end he said, "I've had a wonderful life. I had wonderful children and there are not many things I've wanted to do that I didn't get to." He loved his family and would do anything for them. He was a beloved father and will be missed profoundly.
