Kenyon Dwayne Hackney, 88, of Tallahassee, Florida, died Friday, December 23, 2011, of natural causes. A native of Morehead, Kentucky, who resided half of his life in Arlington, Virginia, Mr. Hackney moved to Tallahassee, in 2004.
