



Kevin Whitney Smith

April 27, 1968 - July 30, 2018

Tallahassee native Kevin Smith died peacefully Monday, July 30 2018 at Tallahassee Memorial Healthcare Center. He was 50 years old.

Kevin was born April 27, 1968, and was a 1986 graduate of Lincoln High School where he played varsity football 4 years. He graduated from the University of Florida with a Bachelor of Science degree in Building Construction, and where he served as President of the Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity. He was a Certified General Contractor and worked with family owned Ajax Building Corporation for many years, including serving as its President. Most recently he was managing DCS Family Properties.

Over time he was active in many local organizations including Leadership Tallahassee; the Board of Governors of the Governor's Club; and President of the Board of Directors of Young Actors Theatre.

Kevin is survived by his son Ty William Smith; his parents Douglas C. and Karen Smith; his brother John Bloxham (Jay) Smith and his wife Bri and their daughters Avery, Kate, and Claire; and numerous aunts, uncles, cousins and dear friends.
