Larry Wayne Minor, 73, of Tallahassee, Florida, passed away on November 22, 2020, after a courageous battle against Parkinson's disease. He was born December 22, 1946, to parents William Otis Minor, Sr. and Juanita Faucette Minor in Graham, NC. Larry is survived by his daughter Rachel Malet and her husband Stephane, daughter Laura Minor, grandson Wes Malet, former spouse Sandi White, and brother William Minor, Jr. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Danny Minor. Larry received his Bachelor's degree from North Carolina State University. He also earned a Master's degree in City Planning from the Georgia Institute of Technology. While at North Carolina State University, Larry was a fencing champion and coach. Larry spent his career as a self-employed consultant working on geographic information systems and transportation planning. He retired in 2016, after consulting for many years with the Florida Department of Transportation. A small family service will be held on a later date at Graham Memorial Park in Graham, NC.
