In addition to her work in education, Faye also embraced her creative side as a beautician and florist, and together with her husband, she was a licensed insurance agent/owner of Eubanks Insurance in Blountstown, Florida.

A longtime member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints in Bristol, Florida, Faye's faith played a central role in her life. Throughout her life she served in countless positions in the Church. The love she had for her Church family was evident through her compassionate service to others.
