Rev. Leadie Catherine Haynes, 82, of Sopchoppy died quietly, surrounded by her family, on Wednesday, March 9, 2011 at the home of her caregiver and daughter, Ann Ferrell, in Tallahassee.

Catherine was born on September 10, 1928 in Okeechobee, FL to Homer and Mamie Starling, Sr.

She was married to Ralph William Haynes , Sr. on March 15, 1947. Catherine received an Associates of Divinity degree from Graceville Theological Bible College in Graceville, FL in 1993.
