



## Luther (Lou) Harold Rhoney

Luther Harold (Lou) Rhoney died on April 25, 2025, following a short illness.

Lou was born in 1934 in Drexel, NC. He married Trina Watson in 1951. He played minor league baseball and served in the Army for two years after which he and Trina moved to Macon, GA and then to Tallahassee in 1960. He worked for Western Union for 30 years and then with the State of Florida Department of Insurance for 15 years. Lou was an avid FSU football and baseball fan for many years and enjoyed playing golf and bowling. He was a handyman extraordinaire and, following retirement, could often be found helping others with projects or making wooden toys.
