Margaret Camp, 84, of Tallahassee passed away peacefully on the morning of March, 30, 2014.

"Madgie", as she was lovingly called by her family, was born February 20, 1930, in Concord, Florida, the daughter of Rev. Arthur C. and Mrs. Sallie Betty Hendley Camp. She graduated from Deland High School and held a B.S. Degree in Education from Florida State University and an M.S. Degree in Education from the University of Georgia. She was retired from the Leon County Schools System where she had been a teacher and librarian. She had been a resident of Westminster Oaks for nearly nine years.

Ms. Camp was a life-long Baptist who had been a member at First Baptist, East Hill Baptist, and Bradfordville First Baptist Churches in Tallahassee.
