Mary V. Horner died December 8th surrounded by her children at her home. She was born July 17th, 1925 in Bloomington, Illinois, the daughter of Catherine Eugenia Dooley and Chauncey Van Note. She was a graduate of St. Clara College, Sinsinawa, Wisconsin. She married Robert B. Horner on December 22nd, 1946 and they moved from Illinois to Jacksonville, Florida in 1948 where Mr. Horner practiced law until his retirement in 1978 when they moved to Tallahassee. Mr. Horner died in 1979.

Mrs. Horner was a woman with many interests, who loved and cherished a wide circle of friends. She had been a partner in Commodore Travel from 1985 to 1993 and had travelled extensively. In the early years of her married life she assumed numerous church and community responsibilities. She was a life member of The Garden Club of Jacksonville and a past board member and a past president of Ginger Circle. For a number of years she wrote a weekly garden column in the Florida Times Union.

Her greatest joy in life, however, were the members of her family. She took pride in all their accomplishments and loved to be in their company. She had a great determination to live life fully and with enthusiasm.
