Mary Louise Schuster, 92, passed away peacefully on Sunday, July 25, 2021 with her daughter by her side. She was born Mary Louise Davis on September 16, 1928 in Richeyville, PA to Mildred and Warren Jefferson Davis. She was a 1945 graduate of Garfield High School in Akron, OH.
