Matthew James Morphonios, 27, a native and lifelong resident of Tallahassee died Friday, April 24th in Tallahassee as a result of injuries sustained in an automobile accident in Tallahassee. He is survived by his wife of six weeks, Katie K. Morphonios.

A graduate of Lincoln High School, Class of 2005 and Tallahassee Community College, Matthew was just shy of a degree from Florida State University and was also a graduate of the Pat Thomas Law Enforcement Academy. For the three years he has been a messenger and driver for Brink's Armored Car Company. Raised in the Pentecostal faith, he and Katie attended the Seventh Day Adventist Church.
