Upon returning from England he graduated from Leon High School in 1976. Lee then attended Georgia Tech University and the University of Florida and then returned to Tallahassee where he earned his Associate's Degree from Tallahassee Community College. He then attended Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University and graduated with honors with a degree in Construction Project Management. During this time, he found his vocation as Project Manager for Gary Fritz Contractors where he excelled until his retirement in 2009. This work included a major renovation of the Chez Pierre Restaurant, along with many other business and home remodeling jobs. Lee excelled in cooking and most importantly loved two and four-legged friends who all benefited from the San Luis Mission Dog Park. All his dogs; Ace, Fred, Brandon, Scout and Samson were his best friends throughout life. In 2010, Lee and his father went on a Deer Lake Methodist Church mission trip to Haiti through the church and Lee always said it was one of the most important things he ever did in his life and always talked fondly of the trip. is survived by his wife of 32 years, Lisa Applegate Spivey, his father, Robert Atwood Spivey, his sister, Hope Spivey Stevenson (Jeff), brother Paul Atwood Spivey (Cindy).
