



Mildred Ann Dawkins

November 6, 1931 - August 24, 2021

Mildred Ann Coleman Dawkins, 89, of Tallahassee, Florida, passed away unexpectedly on August 24, 2021.

Daughter of Eugene Lockey Coleman and Mildred Pledger Coleman, she was born in Tallahassee, Florida, on November 6, 1931.

She graduated from Florida State University with a degree in early childhood education. She married Jack Marshall Dawkins in 1951 and raised five children in Tallahassee, Florida.

She was a longtime church volunteer: serving on committees, teaching Sunday School, singing in the choir, chaperoning youth trips, and working in the church office, first at Calvary United Methodist Church, and later at Saint Paul's United Methodist Church. After Jack's passing in 1991, she began singing with the Tallahassee Community Chorus, through the 2018-2019 season, and volunteering with the Tallahassee Memorial Hospital Auxiliary for 20+ years.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, and youngest son, Robert James Dawkins.

She is survived by her sons, Jack M. Dawkins Jr and wife JuDee, Richard E. Dawkins and wife Deanette, William E. Dawkins and wife Tammie, and daughter Valerie C. Dawkins, all of Tallahassee. Six grandchildren: Douglas Dawkins (Erika) of Upper Marlboro, MD, Kallie Dawkins, Joshua Dawkins, Halie Dawkins, Michaela Dawkins, and Alesia Dawkins, all of Tallahassee; and two great-grandchildren, Jacob and Asher.

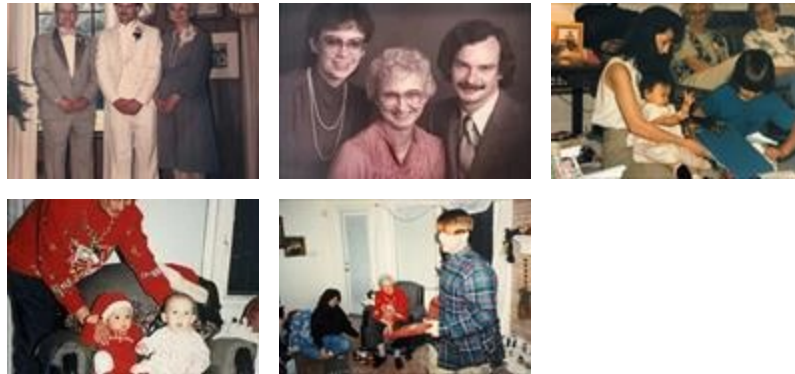

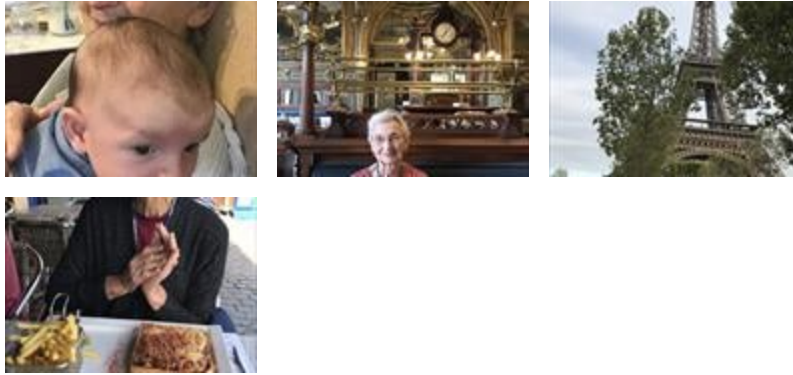
