



## Milton "John" Ford

September 7, 1931 - May 19, 2021

Milton John Ford ("John") of Tallahassee, FL, passed away peacefully at age 89 on May 19, 2021 at his residence. He was born in San Antonio, Texas, on September 7, 1931 to the late Mr. George Henry Ford and the late Mrs. Lois Dorothy (nee Pullin) Ford.

He served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean conflict. He was a graduate of University of Texas at Austin with a major in physics. Mr. Ford resided in the greater West Palm Beach area from 1959-2019, after relocating from Texas. He worked at Pratt and Whitney Aircraft for many years as an instrumentation engineer until his retirement. He was a long-time member of Bow Down Church in West Palm Beach.

Late in life, he desired to serve the Lord through discipling young men in an urban setting. He loved spending time with family, making friends, scuba diving, travel, enjoying a cigar and a glass of scotch, and sharing stories about his time in the Navy and friends and family long past.
