He was educated in India and got his Bachelors of Civil Engineering degree from Guindy Engineering College in Chennai, India. After working for some time in India, he returned for his higher education and received his Masters of Civil Engineering also from Guindy Engineering College. After receiving his degree, he worked for Public Works Department (PWD) for 18 years. Then, he came to the United States and completed his second Masters of Science in Environmental Engineering. He then completed his PhD in Industrial Engineering from University of Miami. He worked for Woodward Clyde Consultants at Tallahassee, Florida for a few years. After that he started working at Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) and was an active employee of FDEP until his demise.

He was the initial founder and active member of the local Tallahassee Tamil Sangam. He hosted yearly Tamil functions and encouraged people to participate and socialize to promote Tamil culture.

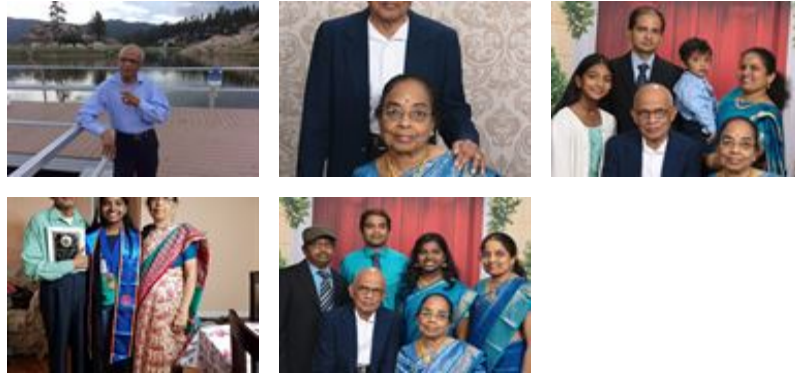
