



Nancy Bee Nation Adams

February 3, 1948 - January 3, 2024

Nancy was born in Brookhaven, Mississippi, the daughter of Dr. Warren Busby Nation and Sarah Elizabeth (Betsy) Bee Nation. The family moved to Tallahassee in 1957. Family members who continue to celebrate Nancy are her husband, Park T. Adams; her son William (Will) Warren Gerstman (Sarah) and grandchildren Annabelle and Grant; her brother, John Nation (Elaine); and nieces Savannah Nation and Nicole McNeil (Brandon).

Upon graduating in 1966 from Leon High School and Mississippi State College for Women in 1970, Nancy embarked on a career as a speech therapist. She served children in Jacksonville and Sarasota, Florida, eventually returning to Tallahassee in 1982 to work in Leon County Schools, a journey of dedication spanning 32 years.

Nancy both participated and contributed to the Tallahassee community. Among the organizations benefitting from her knowledge and enthusiasm for service were Springtime Tallahassee, Tiger Bay, Town Club, The Tallahassee Republican Club, and the Network of Entrepreneurial and Business Advocates (NEBA). Nancy was an avid FSU Seminole, a booster for over 45 years, she loved the games and treasured her seat in the stadium. Traveling the country and overseas was an adventure for Nancy, yet she found the calm of the North Carolina mountains a source of both respite and delight for more than 20 years.

Throughout her life Nancy was dedicated to family and friends, rarely did she meet a stranger as friendships were often formed with her giving heart. Nancy leaves a legacy of a kind, loving, and generous spirit for which she will be remembered with admiration and love.

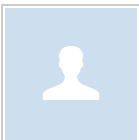
