She was diagnosed with a Bulbar onset of Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) in January of 2013; her body had already begun to lose muscle mass and continued to do so. Ruth had been needing additional oxygen since the previous Sunday and was tending toward sleep; the medical staff said that she went quietly and without stress into unconsciousness.
