



Nicholas George "Nick" Joanos

Nicholas George "Nick" Joanos, 72, passed away Thanksgiving Day at his home in Tallahassee. He is survived by his wife of 42 years Tina Joanos. Nick was a native of Tallahassee and was raised in Thomasville. His parents, now deceased, were George Andrew and Evelyn Kavouklis Joanos.

He was a very active member of Holy Mother of God Greek Orthodox Church, where he held every position on the church council, including numerous times as President. He also was a member of Ahepa and a longtime facilitator of the Greek Food Festival. Nick was honored to receive the Arch Angel Michael Award at Metropolis of Atlanta a few years ago. His love for family and friends compared to no other. Nick was a true Greek with his cooking skills and loved volunteering at parties as so many requested his delicious food.

In addition to his church work Nick was a past President of the Deerlake Middle School PTO, President of his HOA at Venture Out at Panama City Beach and enjoyed his Bridge partners at the Tallahassee Senior Citizens Center. Nick was a graduate of the University of South Florida and was a retired auditor-tax trainer with the State Department of Revenue.

Other survivors include two daughters, Nicole Josey (Eric) and Stephanie Joanos White (Wesley); and his son, George Nicholas Joanos, all of Tallahassee. Also surviving is his sister, Valerie Griner of Thomasville.

The family will receive guests for a visitation on Sunday, November 27th from 4:00 PM until 5:30 PM at Bevis Funeral Home, 200 John Knox Road in Tallahassee.
