Orea (Tom) Thompson was born on October 10, 1943 in DeFuniak Springs, Florida to Johnnie Rhea and Odell Thompson. He went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, February 24, 2021 at his home, due to cancer.

Tom was married to his beloved wife Elaine Thompson on June 24, 1962. In 1966 he was drafted into the Army and worked his way up to a Sargent in Communications. He was a graduate of the University of West Florida and received his bachelor's degree in business. Tom was a devout Christian and ordained minister who preached for 32 plus years.

Tom worked for the State of Florida as a Comptroller/Administrator and retired after 30 years. He then went back to work and was an Administrator for Tallahassee Memorial Hospital and retired in 2020.

Tom is survived by his wife, Elaine; middle son, Anthony (Tony), his wife, Victoria Thompson, and their daughters Alexis and Taylor; youngest son, Christopher (Chris), his wife, Jill Thompson and daughter, Chloe; daughter-in-law, Crystal Thompson, son, Jacob and daughter, Madison; older brother, Charles, his wife, Nellie and youngest brother, Kenneth and his wife, Pat.
