

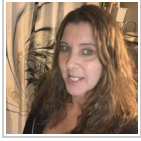


## Page Ward Johnson

August 2, 1923 - November 10, 2015

Page Ward Johnson, age 92, entered into rest November 10, 2015 at the Margaret Dozier Big Bend Hospice House. Page was a native of Marlinton, West Virginia and had lived in Tallahassee since 1966. He served in the U.S. Navy during W.W.II in the South Pacific. Page retired with 20 years of service with the U.S. Federal Bureau of Prisons. He was a member of the American Legion Sauls-Bridges Post #13 and of the Methodist faith. Page was preceded in death by his parents, Alva A. and Ethel Virginia Waugh Johnson, his wife, Anna Bell Johnson.
