



Pamela Gray Nobles

November 20, 1955 - November 7, 2021

Pamela Gray Nobles died on November 7, 2021 after a brave battle against an aggressive form of brain cancer.

Pam was born on November 20, 1955 to June and Charlie Gray. While attending college, Pam was a majorette with the FSU Marching Chiefs. Pam married Tommy Nobles in October 1980 and in 1981 they moved to Franklin County. She began teaching baton twirling and soon opened Pam Nobles Dance Studio. For 39 years her studio impacted hundreds of children and their family members who loved her so much.

She is survived by her husband Michael, her mother June Gray, her sister Cindy Gray, brother-in-law, Mark Nobles, and sister-in-law Beth Nobles. She is also survived by several nieces and nephews, aunts and uncles and cousins. She was predeceased by her first husband, of 35 years, Tommy Nobles; her father Charlie Gray; her aunt Mary and uncle Sammy Gray; and aunt Doris and uncle Arnett Peel.

A memorial service will be held on Friday, November 19th at 11:00 AM at Bevis Funeral Home located at 200 John Knox Road, Tallahassee, FL 32303.
